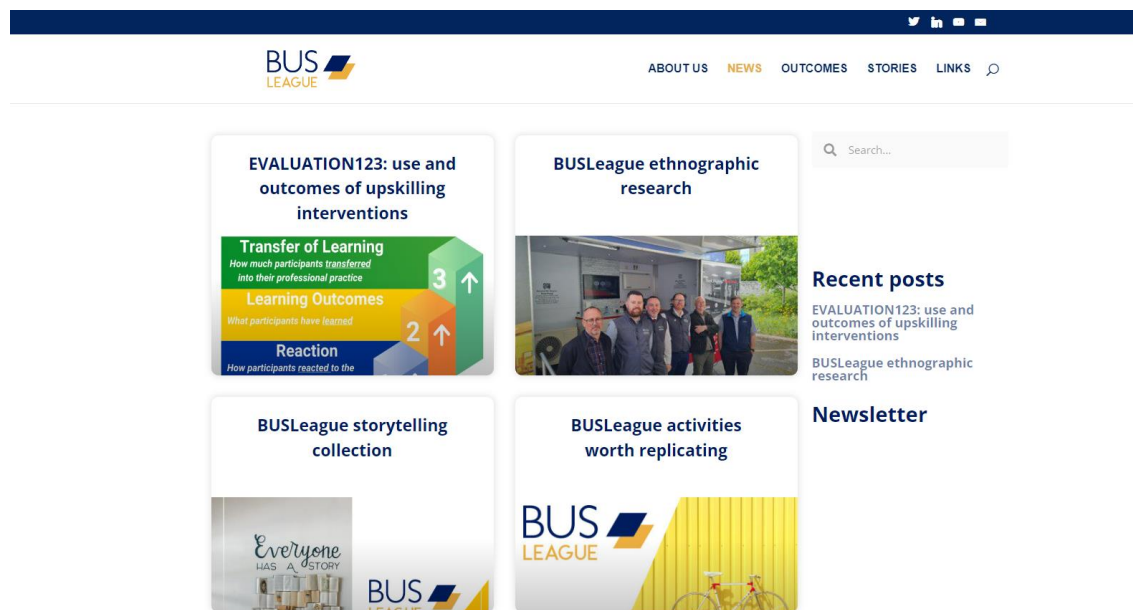

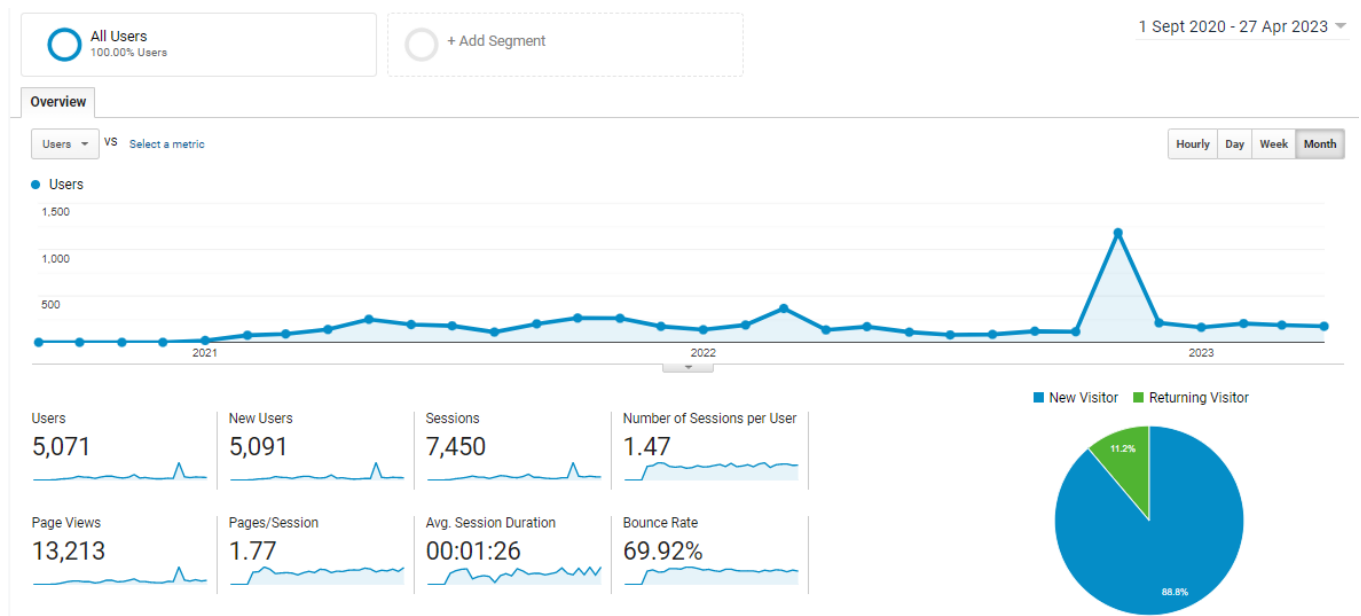

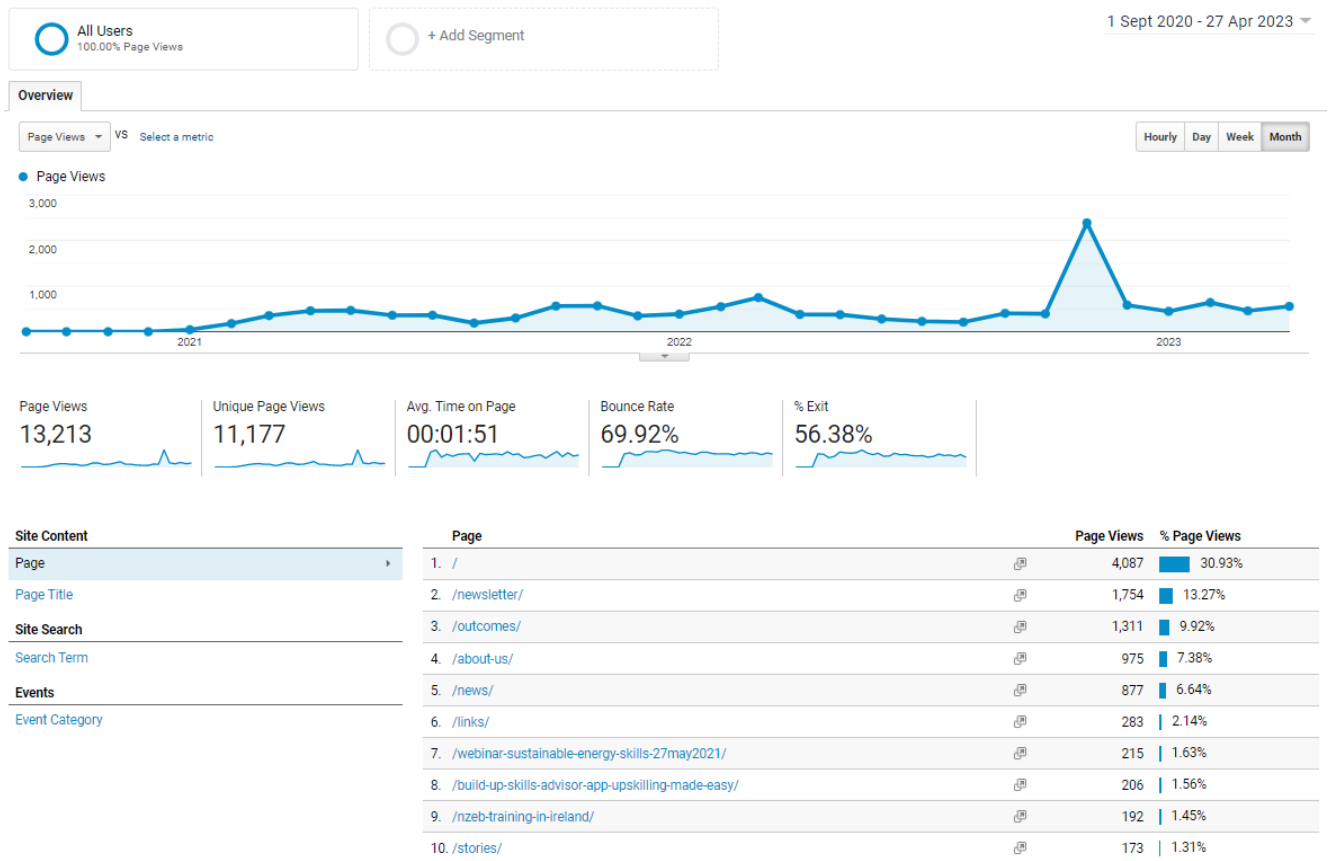

1.1 USERS



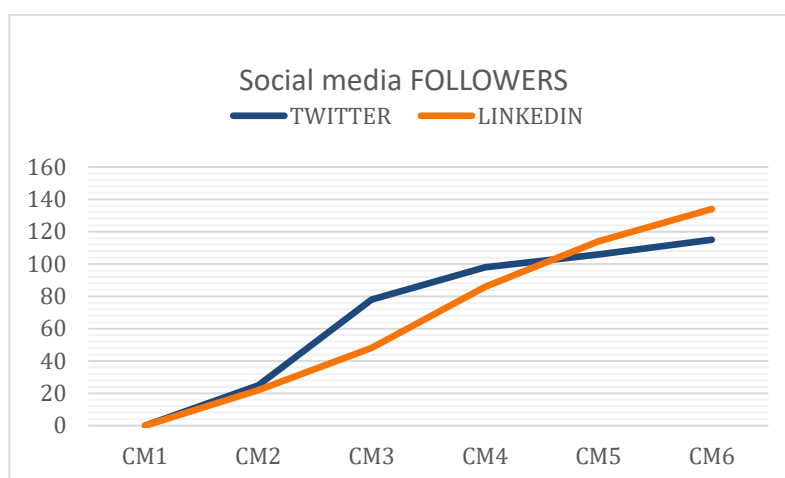
1.2 PAGE VIEWS

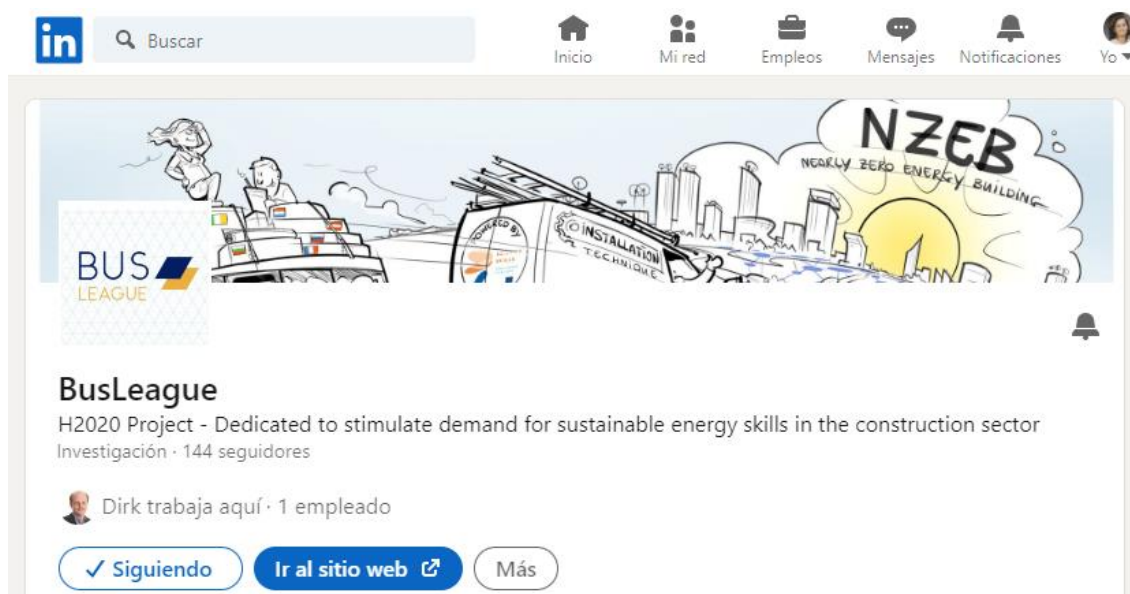

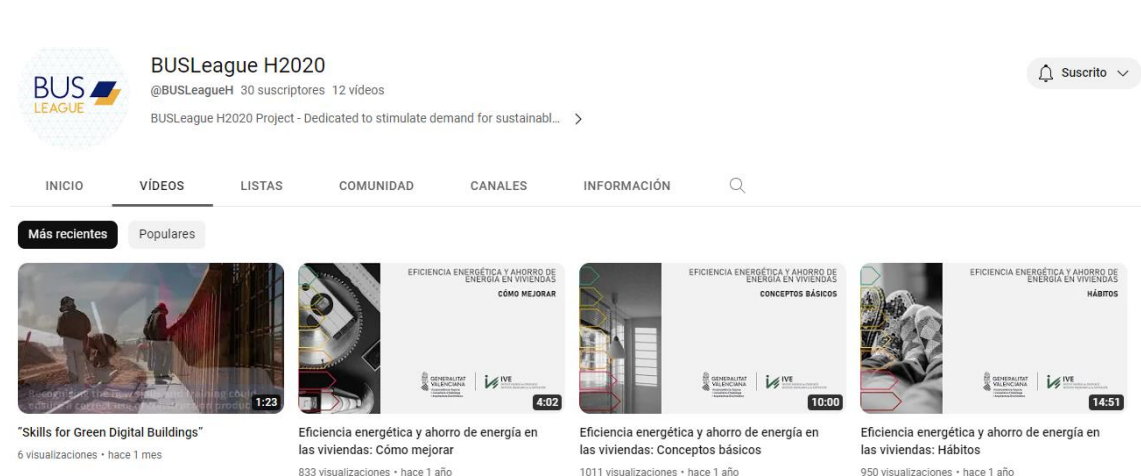

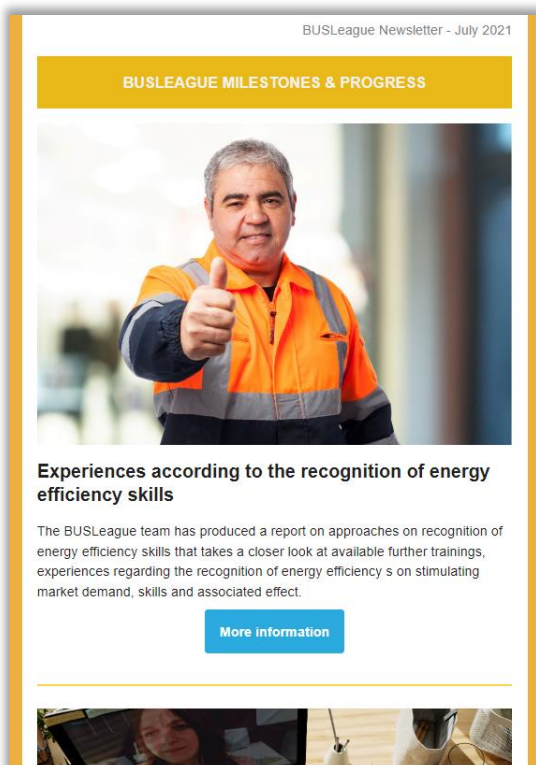
3 E-NEWSLETTER

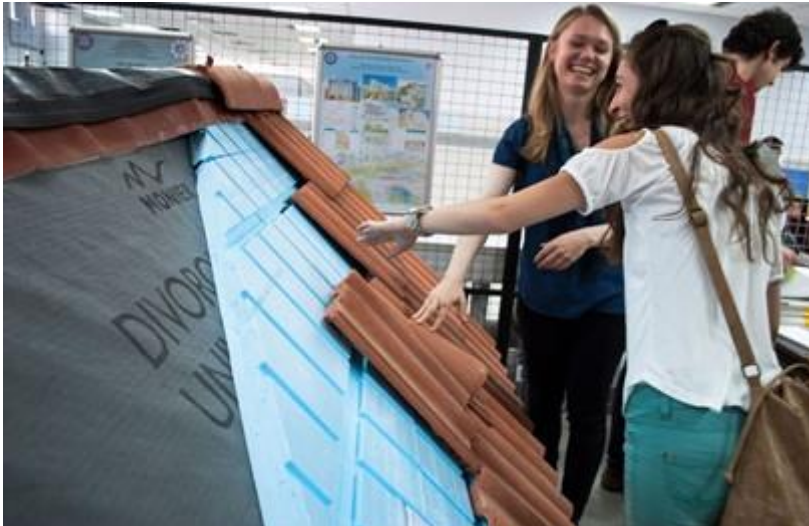
Short description:

The event was hosted by the Professional School of Civil Engineering and Architecture, where most of the planned initiatives took place, and organised by the Energy Efficiency Centre EnEffect and the Bulgarian Chamber of Builders, supported by the Horizon 2020 nZEB Roadshow project and the Black Sea Energy Research Centre (BSERC).

The event offered an insight into successful practices and technological innovations for the design and construction of near-zero energy buildings from Europe and Bulgaria, as well as current trends in professional education and training in the field of energy efficiency and renewable energy.

DEEP RETROFIT DWELLINGS-TYPICAL U-VALUES IN IRELAND [W/(m2K)]

Pitched Roof (insulation at pitch) 0.16 W/(m2K)

Where more than 25 % of the surface of the building envelope undergoes renovation, the energy performance of the building or the renovated part thereof is upgraded in order to meet minimum energy performance requirements with a view to achieving a cost optimal level in so far as this is technically, functionally and economically feasible.

The surface area of the dwelling thermal envelope means the entire surface area of a dwelling through which it can lose heat to the external environment or the ground, including all heat loss areas of walls, windows, floors and roof.

The cost optimal performance level to be achieved is 125 kWh/m2.yr when calculated in DEAP (B2).

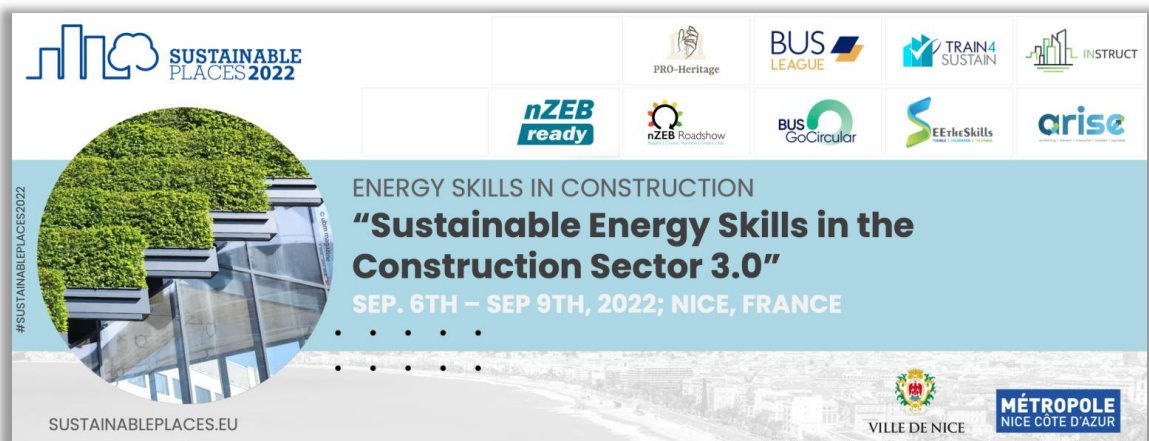
The BUSLeague project participated in the international conference “Sustainable Places 2022”, which this year was a hybrid event, held online and face-to-face in Nice (France).

This 90-minute virtual workshop joins several EU projects to expose their approach (and results) and discuss potential synergies to stimulate future public and private investments in energy-based habitat renovation. The specific focus is to accelerate the training and certification of craftsmen in the construction and fitters' industries and allow these sectors to fully embrace innovative technologies, products, and systems in the energy for buildings field. The objectives are to respond to the challenges of keeping pace with innovation and be more productive and collaborative, thanks to appropriate training and skills building. This will be instrumental in new

services to asset owners and operators and eventually lead towards more resilient, high-quality, user-friendly and age-friendly living environments.

BUSLeague project, represented by Marion Jammet (IGBC), gave a presentation titled "Supporting energy efficiency upskilling through public procurement".

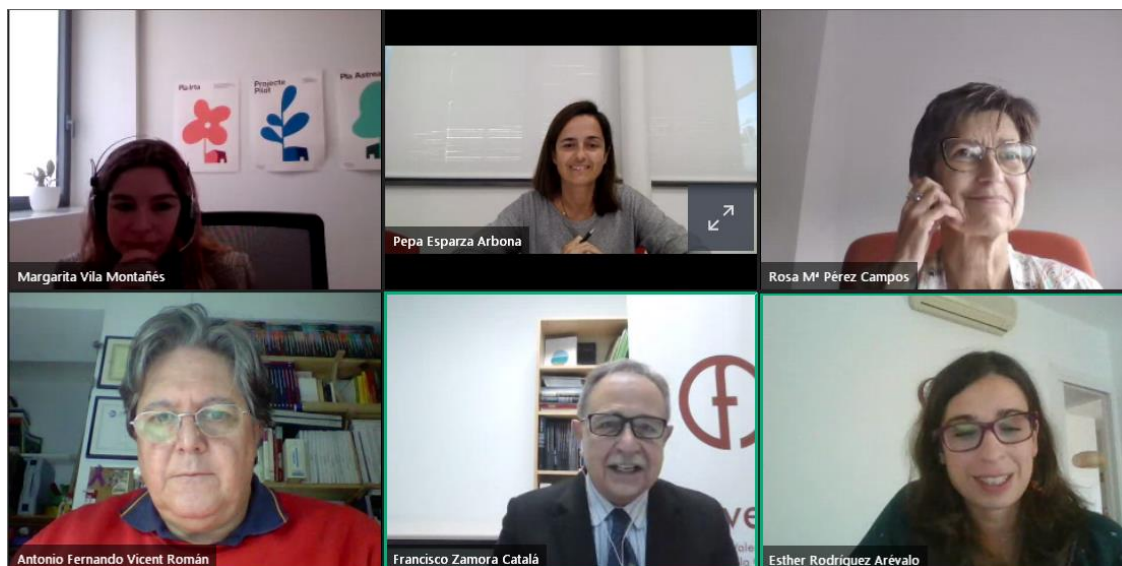

6 NATIONAL FINAL EVENTS

In each country involved, the national partners presented the project results in a national-level event in the local language. These events were independent of training events, as they had different scopes and target groups.

6.1 National final event in Austria

On Wednesday, 25 January 2023, the Austrian team of the BUSLeague project organized an event entitled “Transforming Austria, Building Competencies”. The representatives from various organizations and sectors listened to a series of diverse and exciting presentations and then joined in the discussion.



“The Elephant in the Room!” The story is familiar: in a dark room, several people are asked to describe what the elephant is like by touching it. Each person touches a different body part and describes it from their perspective. That’s how it is with finding solutions for buildings and climate protection. Decarbonizing buildings is a complex undertaking. It needs the participation and cooperation of science, politics, educational institutions, developers, planners, professionals and craftsmen.



6.2 National final event in Spain

The [Jaume I University](#) (UJI, Castellón) and [Iberdrola](#) (energy company) organised the conference "Good practices for the decarbonisation of cities: key aspects for buildings" on 16 November 2022. [Download agenda](#). The speakers at the conference had different but complementary professional profiles, which enriched the subsequent debate: policymakers, researchers, teachers, energy industry professionals, architects and engineers.



The main objective of the conference was to raise the key aspects to be taken into account in the building sector to minimise energy consumption and emissions in buildings, both during the construction process and during their use and maintenance. Throughout the different presentations, topics such as the current general framework for the energy renovation of buildings, existing subsidies, as well as the necessary training and recognition of qualified professionals to be able to develop these projects with quality were discussed.

The Valencia Institute of Building (IVE), represented by architect Pepa Esparza, highlighted the importance of training but also of other formulas on which the European H2020 projects [BUSLeague](#) and [BUS-GoCircular](#) are working, and which aim to stimulate the recruitment of qualified professionals in energy efficiency and circularity. For example, the certification of micro-skills onsite, the recognition of these skills through apps, lists, registers or skills passports and, finally, the inclusion of "training clauses" in green public tenders and financial mechanisms.

6.3 National final event in Ireland

A full house was in attendance at an energetic event titled ‘decarbonising our built environment – making sure we have the right skills’ held at the aptly named 1 Windmill Lane on Dublin’s docklands on February 16th 2023. Jointly hosted by Irish Green Building Council (IGBC) and Technological University of the Shannon (TUS), marking the completion of the EU Horizon-funded BUSLeague programme in Ireland, the event brought together members of the public, construction companies, workers and suppliers along with the education sector, policy makers and government departments to discuss and debate construction skills.



The panel discussion was expertly moderated by IGBC’s Marion Jammet, who has been instrumental in delivering BUSLeague in Ireland from the beginning (2020). A fast-paced panel discussion centred around questions relating to ambitious targets, challenges to upskilling, consumer engagement, building trust and the need for both more construction workers and more upskilling.

Patrick Atkinson, CEO of Chadwick’s DIY store, which participated in implementing the BUSLeague project, spoke of the evolution of interest from both trade and householders in energy-efficient materials over the past ten years and the constant need to upskill Chadwick’s employees.



Dr Alan Power, who is a member of the Expert Group on Future Skills Needs (EGFSN), an independent, non-statutory body comprising representatives from business, the education and training sector, the enterprise development sector, the trade unions and government departments, spoke in particular about construction skills being in transition and that the future lies in greater digital supports for construction. The EGFSN plays a key role in identifying

enterprises' current and future skills needs and advising the Irish Government on these needs. Alan Cawley of major building company Sisk spoke of the need to have in-house staff trained as sustainability champions on every building site (they currently have 80 sites in Ireland). Eloise Heron of the Society of Chartered Surveyors spoke of the need for career guidance in secondary education to encourage greater take-up of construction courses at third level and of the need to support greater female participation in construction roles in general.

Seamus Hoyne recounted over ten years of Build Up Skills (BUS) endeavours in Ireland. He described how TUS's new collaborative hub for upskilling, DASBE (Digital Academy for Sustainable Skills in the Built Environment), had developed 20 new sustainability programmes in two years delivered through online, blended, face-to-face and practical training. He left the event to deliver an online lecture on the residential energy retrofit programme in a back room, while the crowd continued the evening, networking with guest speakers, IGBC and TUS BUSLeague teams and guests.

6.4 National final event in Bulgaria

On January 17th, a conference under the motto "Education and Training for Energy Efficiency and RES in Buildings" was held in TSUM, Sofia, as well as in an online format. The conference marked the end of the BUS League project, providing a framework for a continuous professional development system in Bulgaria, and the beginning of the BUILD UP Skills Bulgaria 2030 initiative, which aims to develop a road map for increasing knowledge and skills in the construction sector.

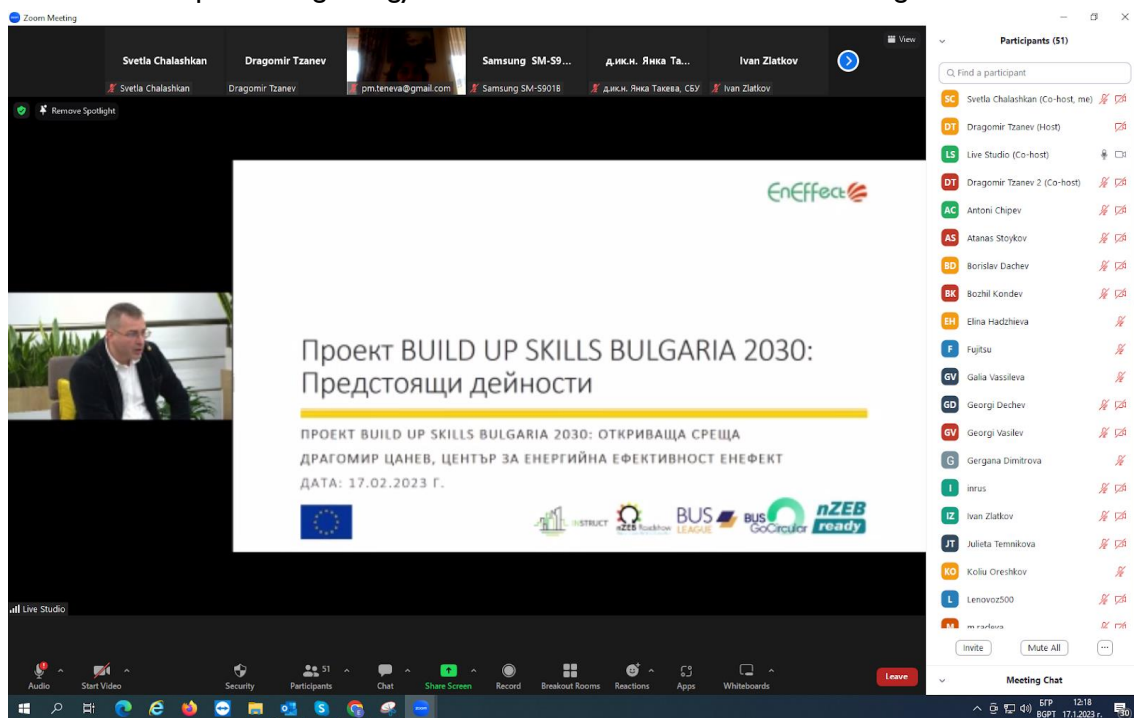


The event was attended by experts from the Sustainable Energy Development Agency (SEDA), the National Agency for Vocational Education and Training (NAVET), the Bulgarian Construction Chamber (BCC) and the Bulgarian Association for Insulation in Construction (BAIS), among many others.

The focus of attention was on the role of vocational education in the implementation of national goals for energy efficiency in the building sector, as well as trends in vocational education and training related to mandatory changes in state educational standards in professional areas in the construction field. The results of the BUILD UP Skills initiative from 2011 to 2022 were also presented.

"The transition to clean energy forms a legislative framework - European, together with the challenges of the Green Deal. This includes the Energy Efficiency Directive, the Energy Performance of Buildings Directive and the Directive on promoting energy from renewable sources, which form the challenges for Member States. The other aspect is the energy union in Europe, which has multiple dimensions such as energy security, internal European energy market, energy efficiency and decarbonization," said Ivaylo Alexiev, executive director of AUER. In this context, he outlined the development of vocational education and training as a primary task and emphasized the need for hard work by all professional communities.

The experts focused on the role of business as a source of knowledge about new products and technologies in construction. EnEffect's experts presented in detail the outcomes of the BUSLeague, which support the creation of a qualification framework for increasing knowledge and skills for implementing energy-efficient and circular solutions in buildings.



"This initiative has over a ten-year background of cooperation in the field of professional education and training," commented Dragomir Tzanev, executive director of EnEffect - project coordinator. "In Bulgaria, we managed to train over 2,000 construction specialists, but this is far from enough. Our strategic goals for 2030 are linked to an increasing contribution of the construction sector to the green energy transition. This, in turn, necessitates the creation of a framework for a system of continuing professional qualification in construction, for which the BUS League project is instrumental", he added.

6.5 National final event in France

Alliance Villes Emploi and [ADEME](#) (The French Agency for Ecological Transition), organized on February 2nd 2023, a webinar dedicated to the evolution of markets and skills in the building sector.



This meeting was attended by 136 participants and was organized in two main sessions:

- **Presentation of the results of the European project "BUSleague" on the markets of energy renovation and the rise in skills of companies with a focus on the Cambrésis country.**

6.6 National final event in the Netherlands

Due to the impact of the COVID19-pandemic, which also affected the staff of ISSO working on BUSLeague, it was not feasible to have the national final event within the project duration. As part of the BUS-NL-project reviving the skills network in The Netherlands and developing the skills roadmap to 2030, two meetings are organised:

- One on April 14th, 2023, by the supporting parties of BUSLeague Techniek Nederland and Wij Techniek (former: OTIB), related to the training and education network connected to ISSO and these organisations. About 100 high-level staff members of education and training providers (including company schools), policymakers, etc., attend. BUSLeague results were presented by the supporting organisations Techniek Nederland and Wij Techniek.



- One on June 15th, 2023, by the partners of the BUS-NL-project for the whole building and installation sector, including the government and its subsidiaries. During these meetings, the results of BUSLeague will be presented and discussed, with the aim of including them in the roadmap on skills for the coming years. For more information: [click here](#).

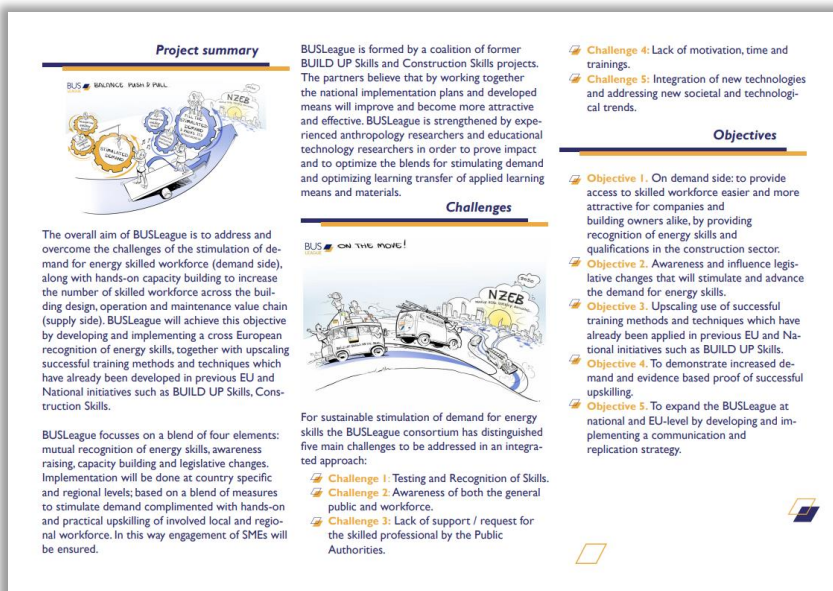

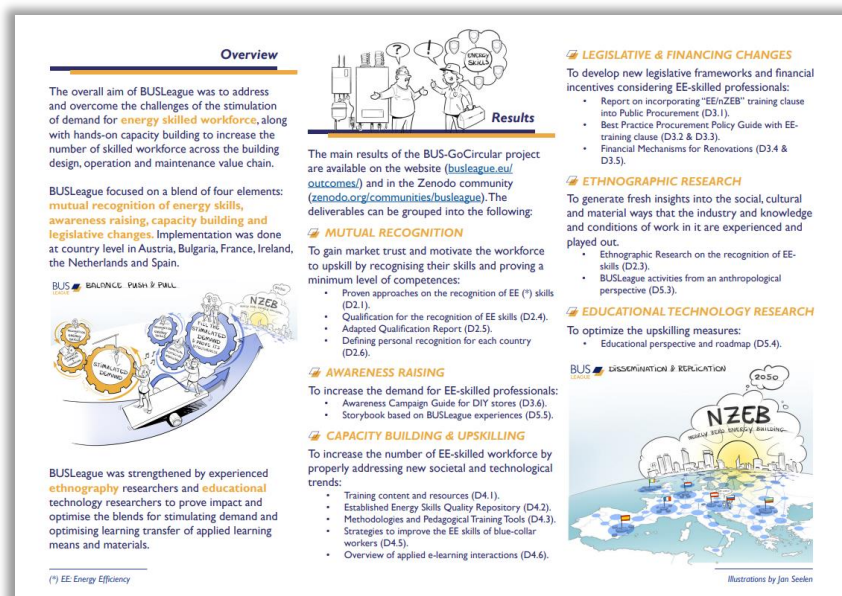

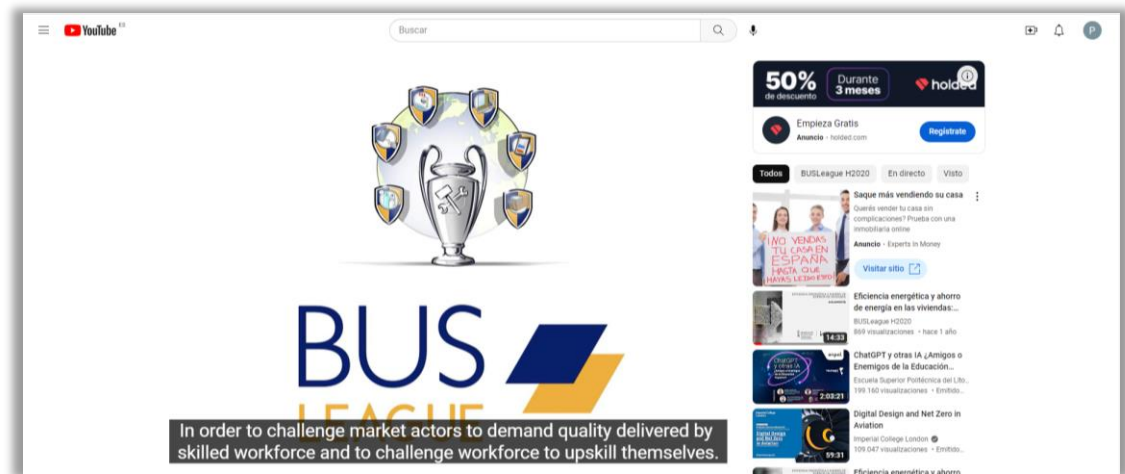

8 UNDERTAKEN DISSEMINATION ACTIVITIES
